(2008) 95 minutes PG

Actor Leonardo DiCaprio produces and narrates this urgent and transformational look at where we've been, where we're going and - most important - how we can change. Thinkers from Mikhail Gorbachev to Stephen Hawking to sustainable-design expert William McDonough and dozens more reveal the current, critical state of life on the planet.

October 20 **Homeland: Four Portraits of Native Action**

In one of the least known but most important human rights stories today, nearly all 317 Native American reservations in the US face grave environmental threats - toxic waste, strip mining, oil drilling and nuclear contamination. In the face of such a widespread crisis, can one person make a difference? For the extraordinary subjects of *Homeland*, the answer is yes.

In the traditionally Irish-American working-class neighborhood of South Boston, MA, a new kind of building has taken shape. From wheatboard cabinetry to recycled steel, bamboo flooring to dual-flush toilets, the Macallen building is something different: a leader in the emerging field of environmentally friendly design.

A guilty New York liberal decides to practice what he preaches for one year. He turns off the electricity, stops making garbage, gives up TV, taxis and take out and becomes a walking, bicycling, composting, tree hugging, polar bear saving local food-eating citizen, all while taking his baby daughter and caffeine loving retail-obsessed, television-addicted wife along with him. Can he save the planet without driving his family crazy??
