## ELIGIBILITY

Artists 18+ living in Connecticut, Massachusetts, Rhode Island or New York. Works must be completed since January 2008. Only original works will be accepted (no "giclee" or reproductions). Accepted art must be **HAND DELIVERED**. No photography or digital collage will be accepted for this exhibition. Acceptable mediums include:

**Painting, drawing, mixed media, and fiber arts:** Wall hung work must not exceed 36" framed in either direction. Wall hung work must be wired and ready for hanging.

**Sculpture:** Sculpture works must not exceed 24" w x 24" d x 72" h and must weigh less than 150 lbs. All sculptural work must either be free standing or include a sturdy pedestal.

**Video works:** Artist must supply equipment for any DVD works, if selected.

## ENTRY FEE

The ENTRY FEE is \$25 for up to two artworks. Each artist may submit up to two artworks for consideration. Checks should be made out to the **Friends of the Fairfield Public Library**.

Entries should be submitted on a CD-Rom or DVD formatted for a PC. CD/DVDs will NOT be returned. Images should be in jpeg format, no larger than 8" in either direction with a 300 DPI resolution. Please name files with *artist's last name.first initial.abbreviated title. image number to correspond to ENTRY FORM (1 or 2)*. Example: j.doe.title.1.jpg

## NOTIFICATION

All accepted artists will be notified by email or phone by 5pm on April 12, 2011. Once accepted, artists will be asked for a current CV and artist's statement for inclusion in a gallery binder.

## AWARDS

The juror will select a first, second, and third place winner. These three award winners will be granted a three person show at the Bruce S. Kershner Gallery from January 8 - February 19, 2012.

## SALES

The Friends of the Fairfield Public Library will retain a 25% commission for works sold during the exhibition. Sold works will remain in the exhibition until the end of the show. Artists will be paid no later than 30 days after the close of the exhibit.

## INSURANCE

The Friends of the Fairfield Public Library insures accepted artwork for up to \$1000 of value as determined by an appraisal or proven history of sales.

## AGREEMENT

By submitting your work to this exhibition, all artists agree to allow reproductions of their digital files and/or photographs taken of their art for educational, publicity, and archival purposes.
